### **Luke 24:13-35; Mark 16:12-13**

#### **Appearances of Jesus after the Resurrection:**

#### **I. Sad Journey**

#### **II. “Stranger” Joins**

**“And it came to pass, that, while they communed together and \_\_\_\_\_, Jesus \_\_\_\_\_ drew near, and went with them. But their eyes were holden (\_\_\_\_\_) that they should not know him. And he said unto them, What manner of communications are these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are \_\_\_\_\_?” Luke 24:15-17**

“they communed together and reasoned,” –

“Jesus himself drew near,” –

“their eyes were holden” –

“What manner of communications are these that ye have one to another, as ye walk, and are sad?” –

### III. “Stranger” Informed

- Facts of Jesus

“And the one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answering said unto him, Art thou only a \_\_\_\_\_ in Jerusalem, and hast not known \_\_\_\_\_ which are come to pass there in these days? And he said unto them, \_\_\_\_\_? And they said unto him, Concerning Jesus of Nazareth, which was a prophet mighty in \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ before God and all the people: And how the chief priests and our rulers \_\_\_\_\_ him to be condemned to death, and have crucified him.” Luke 24:18-20

“Art thou only a stranger in Jerusalem, and has not known the things” –

“Concerning Jesus of Nazareth,” –

- Beliefs of Disciples

“But we trusted (\_\_\_\_\_) that it had been he which should have redeemed (\_\_\_\_\_) Israel: and beside all this, to day is the \_\_\_\_\_ day since \_\_\_\_\_ were done. Yea, and certain women also of \_\_\_\_\_ company made us astonished, which were early at the sepulcher; And when they found not his body, they came, saying, that they had also seen a vision of angels, which said that he was alive. And certain of \_\_\_\_\_ which were with us went to the sepulcher, and found it even so as the women had said: but him they saw not.” Luke 24:21-24

### IV. “Stranger” Teaches

“Then he said unto them, O \_\_\_\_\_, and slow of heart to \_\_\_\_\_ all that the \_\_\_\_\_ have spoken: Ought not Christ to have suffered \_\_\_\_\_, and to enter into his glory? And beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he expounded unto them in all the scriptures \_\_\_\_\_ concerning himself.” Luke 24:25-27

“O fools, and slow of heart to believe” –

“suffered these things, and to enter into his glory?” –

“he expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself.” –

*“Our Lord’s exposition of these passages has not been preserved as a discourse, but probably his explanations formed the basis of apostolic interpretations of the Old Testament in the sermons in Acts and in the Epistles.” John Wycliffe p. 1069*

## V. “Stranger” Revealed

**“And they drew nigh unto the village, whither they went: and he made as though he would have gone further. But they \_\_\_\_\_ him, saying, Abide with us: for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent. And he went into tarry with them. And it came to pass, as he sat at meat with them, he took bread, and blessed it, and brake, and gave to them. And their eyes were opened, and they \_\_\_\_\_ him; and he vanished out of their sight. Luke 24:28-31**

“he made as though he would have gone further.” –

“Abide with us:” –

“he took break, and blessed it, and brake, and gave to them.” –

“And their eyes were opened, and they knew him;” –

“he vanished out of their sight.” –

## VI. “Stranger” Inspired

**“And they said one to another, Did not our heart \_\_\_\_\_ within us, while he \_\_\_\_\_ with us by the way, and while he \_\_\_\_\_ to us the scriptures?” Luke 24:32**

## VII. “Stranger” Declared

“And they rose up the same hour, and returned to Jerusalem, and found the \_\_\_\_\_ gathered together, and \_\_\_\_\_ that were with them, Saying, The Lord is risen \_\_\_\_\_, and hath appeared to Simon. And they told \_\_\_\_\_ were done in the way, and how he was known of them in breaking of bread.” Luke 24:33-35

“rose up the same hour,” –

“The Lord is risen indeed,” –

“And they told what things were done in the way,” –

### Gospel of Mark’s Mention of this Event

“After that he appeared in another \_\_\_\_\_ unto two of them, as they walked, and went into the country. And they went and told it unto the residue: neither believed they them.” Mark 16:12-13
